Effective October 1, 2010, the name of the person (or contract number or other unique identifier assigned by the Emergency Response Information (ERI) provider) registered with the ERI provider is required to be entered on the shipping paper in association with (before, after, above or below) the ER telephone number **UNLESS** the ERI provider registrant's name is already entered elsewhere on the shipping paper in a prominent, readily identifiable and clearly visible manner. This also applies in cases where the shipper that is noted on the shipping paper is not using an ERI provider, but instead is using its own ER telephone number. If that shipper's name is already entered elsewhere on the shipping paper in a prominent, readily identifiable and clearly visible manner, it, too, is not required to be entered a second time in association with the ER telephone number.
